This is a petition u/s 438 Cr.P.C praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 113 dated 16.07.2016 under Sections 306 of IPC, 1860 as amended upto date registered at Police Station Kalka, District Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per allegations, Adesh Kumar had committed suicide and named the petitioner. On the last date the following contention was noticed:

“Learned counsel states that the petitioner has no connection with the deceased and she has no idea why she was named by the deceased in the suicide note.”

Today, learned DAG pointed out that the petitioner had lent money to the deceased at very usurious rate of interest and because of that pressure the deceased had committed suicide.

Learned Senior counsel has argued that the invocation of Section 306 IPC is highly debatable in the face of this allegation. Moreover as per him, the handwriting on the suicide note is totally different from the signature appended at the bottom thereof.

Learned DAG has stated that this issue is also before the police and that is why the suicide note has been sent to FSL for comparing if the handwriting on the suicide note is of the same person who has signed underneath.

In this circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to him.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 11.08.2016 or any other date as and when his presence is required. In the event of arrest of the petitioner,
