Petitioners have preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to give police protection to the petitioners and also issue a direction to respondents No.4 to 6 not to interfere with the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners only prays for the relief that the representation dated 22.07.2015 (Annexure P-2), moved to the SHO, Bathinda, copy of which has been sent to SSP, Bathinda, by the petitioner-Simranpreet Kaur, be considered and requested that the DSP may be directed to look into the said representation.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 to 6 states that he has no objection to this prayer.

Learned counsel respondent Nos.4 to 6 contends that respondent No.4 has neither given beatings nor interfered in the life of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos.4 to 6 further states that the private respondents will not interfere in the life of the petitioners nor will give any kind of threat to them.

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioners wants to withdraw this petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
