Prayer is under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of regular bail to the petitioner Gurpreet Singh in case FIR No.17 dated 08.02.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 341, 506 & 34 of Indian Penal Code (Section 307 IPC added later on) registered with Police Station Odhan, District Sirsa.

As per the allegations petitioner along with three other co-accused are alleged to have inflicted injuries on the complainant Bansi Singh. Present petitioner is alleged to have inflicted iron rod blow on the head of Bansi Singh, which has been opined to be dangerous to life.

It is contended that there is a version and cross version. Apart

from that there is delay of 7 days in lodging of the FIR. It is next contended that the petitioner is in custody since 4.6.2015 and no prosecution witness has yet been examined.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Chander Singh does not dispute the custody period and that evidence of prosecution is yet to commence.

Without going into the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future, present petition is allowed and the petitioner Gurpreet Singh is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, Sirsa.

Petition stands disposed of.
