Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.83 dated 13.11.2014, registered at Police Station Bhadson, Patiala, under Sections 308, 341, 323, 427 and 34 IPC.
