The petitioner as a member of unlawful assembly, is alleged to have helped his co-accused in construction of a wall by supplying bricks lying on the spot. Petitioner is not named in the FIR but it is on the basis of CCTV footage indicating his participation that he has been involved in the case. No injury is attributed to the petitioner. He has been in custody since 25.03.2016. Challan has already been presented.

In view of the above circumstances, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court, subject to the condition that he will not in any manner directly or indirectly threaten any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
