Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.179 dated 18.4.2016, under Sections 420 and 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Central Faridabad, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that at the time of issuing notice of motion in the case, the contention of the petitioner was recorded that he has neither signed the bills nor made any entry in the ledger and the receipts, given to the shopkeepers.

However, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI

Chhatterpal states that the petitioner, who is agent of M/s Sukam Power Limited, has taken advantage of the ailment of the complainant and has issued forged bills and made fraudulent entry in the ledger and the receipts. The bills were signed by the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the nature of the allegations against the petitioner that he has forged the bills, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
