JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by Vishal Grover, feeling apprehension of his arrest, in case bearing FIR No.91 dated 20.06.2016, under Sections 406, 420 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Nawanshahar, District SBS Nagar.

At the time of issuance of notice of motion by this Court on August 01, 2016, the following order was passed:-

“Notice of motion for 19.09.2016.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the investigation. In the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on pre-arrest bail at the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer subject to the conditions, as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C”.

At the very outset of the arguments, learned State counsel has fairly conceded that in compliance of the order dated August 01, 2016, petitioner has already joined the investigation. He has further submitted on

instructions from HC Harpal Singh that further custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required. Even otherwise, a glance at the controversies as well as other facts transpires that the entire case is based on documentary evidence.

Taking into consideration the above facts of the case, interim order dated August 01, 2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions, as envisaged under section 438(2) Cr.P.C and shall enure during the pendency of the trial.
