Prayer in this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for setting aside the order dated 02.07.2015, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate, First Class, Chandigarh (Annexure P-3), whereby the application moved by the complainant-Ved Parkash (petitioner herein) for further investigation in case FIR No. 88 dated 20.04.2006 under Sections 420, 380, 419, 467, 468, 471, read with Section 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Industrial Area, Chandigarh, has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that the accused persons/respondent Nos. 2 to 7 have been acquitted by the trial Court vide its order dated 19.02.2016 and, therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.
