Learned counsel for the petitioner states that a status quo order has been passed by the civil court and one S.I. Mohan Lal and his son S.I. Paramjit Singh are threatening and pressurizing the petitioner to leave the land in dispute.

It being so, it is ordered that since status quo order has been passed by the civil court, let the petitioner move before the civil court for breach of the order. If some threats are given, the petitioner can approach the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala.

Since, the petitioner claims that she has already moved an application for the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, therefore, he is directed to contact with the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, with his grievance, who shall look into the matter, in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
