Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.110 dated 01.03.2016, registered at Police Station Shahabad, District Kurukshetra, under Section 379-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Learned State counsel has brought to my notice that 30 cases are pending against the present petitioner and most of the cases have been registered against her under Sections 379 and 382 IPC. Learned State

counsel filed list of those FIRs, registered against the present petitioner.

As per the allegations of prosecution in the present case, it is a case of snatching of gold ornaments and the present petitioner is one of the accused, who participated in the commission of offence.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and also the fact that so many cases are pending against the petitioner, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to be released on bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.

However, as the petitioner has been in custody since 07.03.2016, therefore, trial Court is directed to expedite the trial by giving short adjournments or by adjourning the case on day to day basis, if requires. Concerned Investigating Officer/Station House Officer is also directed to produce all the remaining prosecution witnesses for examination before learned trial Court at the earliest on next two-three dates.
