The petitioners have sought a direction to respondent Nos. 3 and 4, claiming that they are being repeatedly called by the police, though they are not required in any cognizable offence.

Notice was issued to the Advocate General, Punjab.

On the instructions of ASI Ranbir Kumar, it has been informed by the State counsel that the petitioners till date are not required in any criminal case, but they might be required for some information by the police in near future.

Taking into consideration the above said circumstances as existing today, it is ordered that in case the petitioners are required for any enquiry by the police, they will be issued a seven days prior notice by the SHO of Police Station Kotwali, Patiala.

This order will remain operative for a period of one year and will be applicable in the circumstances mentioned in the petition only.
