JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No.98 dated 27.10.2011, under Sections 406/34 of IPC registered at Police Station Rahon, District S.B.S. Nagar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.
2. Vide order dated June 10, 2016, parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court, for getting their statements recorded. As complainant-Gurjit Kaur is residing in Italy, therefore, her mother-Tarsem Kaur, who is attorney of the complainant as well as accused persons, namely, Baldev Singh, his wife Harjinder Kaur and Baldev Singh being attorney of accused No.3 Satnam Singh as he is also residing at Italy, have suffered statements on 14.06.2016 that due to intervention of the respectables of the area, they have arrived at compromise voluntarily and

without any pressure from any side. In compliance thereof, report of trial Court has been received, wherein, it has been categorically observed that the matter has been compromised between the parties voluntarily and without any pressure, threat or coercion.

3. So, in view of circumstances narrated above as well as the observations made in cases reported as ***Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab & Anr. 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*** and ***Narinder Singh and Ors. vs. State of Punjab & Anr., (2014) 6 SCC 466***, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for the benefit of the parties and would certainly bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.98 dated 27.10.2011, under Sections 406/34 of IPC registered at Police Station Rahon, District S.B.S. Nagar, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed qua the petitioners.
