RITU BAHRI, J. (Oral)

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners does not want to press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.

However, the personal presence of the petitioners are exempted before the trial Court, subject to the following conditions:- (i) petitioners shall be represented through counsel; (ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings; (iii) shall not dispute his/their identity as an accused; (iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in his/their absence but in the presence of his/their counsel; (v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the trial Court; and (vi) any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.
