The learned counsel for the petitioners contends that an FIR was registered, but now on the basis of the statement of petitioner No. 1, recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C., the said case is being cancelled.

It being so, without waiting for the appearance of private respondents No. 5 and 6, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana and Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda-respondents No. 2 and 3 herein respectively, to assess threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if any threat is found, grant necessary protection to them.
