A perusal of the file reveals that the instant petition was filed for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise. Parties were directed to appear before learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate concerned to get their statements recorded vide order dated December 14, 2015 but the parties did not appear. Subsequent thereto, at the request of learned counsel for the petitioners, another direction was given to the parties to appear before the trial Court on July 18, 2016 for getting their statements recorded subject to payment of cost to the tune of Rs.5,000/- by the petitioners with the District Legal Services Authority but it appears that neither the cost has been deposited with the District Legal Services Authority nor the parties appeared before the Court concerned. Even intimation in this regard has also been received from the office of District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana.

In view of the above narrated facts and circumstances, it appears that the petitioners are no more interested in pursuing the instant petition. As such, the same is dismissed for non-prosecution as well as for non-compliance of the orders dated 14.12.2015 and 20.05.2016.
