Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.24 dated 13.02.2016, registered under Sections 323, 324, 325, 379, 148 and 149 (offence under Section 325 of 'IPC' was added lateron) of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station E-Division, Amritsar, District Amritsar, the petitioners are being prosecuted.

Mr. Kashmir Singh, learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 6 states that indeed there is compromise arrived at between the parties. This Court had made an order dated July 28, 2016, directed the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate to record the statements of the parties in view of compromise and verify that whether the same is genuine or not.

Now, there is a report from District & Sessions Judge,

Amritsar, showing that the statements of the parties have been recorded and compromise that is arrived at between the parties with the intervention of the respectable persons is genuine and without any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In that view of the matter, FIR No.24 dated 13.02.2016, registered under Sections 323, 324, 325, 379, 148 and 149 (offence under Section 325 of 'IPC' was added lateron) of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station E-Division, Amritsar, District Amritsar, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
