JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner/accused in case FIR No.390 dated 23.12.2015, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Ambala City, District Ambala.

It was contended that the petitioner is working as Statistical Assistant in the office of Principal Medical Officer, Ambala and has no concern with the office relating to issuance of birth certificates.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by S.I. Mahal Singh, submits that in the detailed inquiry submitted by the Economic Wing, co-accused Lakhwinder Singh, who is stated to be a *Tout*, has specifically named the petitioner-Ashwani Tyagi, as having received a sum of Rs.4,000/- for getting a fake Certificate of Desi Gulati.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
