The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.51,
dated 2.4.2016, registered under Sections 379-B/411 of the IPC, at Police
Station Division No.5, District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was
not arrested from the spot and that he has now been in custody for the
last three months.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Gurdev

Singh, has accepted this factual assertion but states that one stolen mobile phone has been recovered from the petitioner.

Be that as it may, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.
