JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, preferred by Amrik Singh, seeking regular bail in case FIR No.57 dated 01.06.2016, under Sections 326, 341, 34 of Indian Penal Code and 307, 323, 324 of IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana.

Allegations against the petitioner are that on 31.05.2016 at about 09:30 p.m., Shukar Singh and Amrik Singh-petitioner stopped Sher Singh (nephew of the complainant) and started abusing him, at that time Shukar Singh was having a soti fitted with an iron grari of cycle and gave its blow on the right and left side of the head of Sher Singh. On sustaining injuries he fell down. There is no specific attribution to the petitioner that he caused any injury to Sher Singh. Moreover, petitioner was arrested in this case on 3rd June, 2016 subjected to custodial interrogation and thereafter, he was remanded to judicial custody.

Meaning thereby, he is no more required for further interrogation.

Moreover, presentation of challan and disposal thereof is likely to take sufficient long time. In the given circumstances, it would not be desirable to keep the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

Taking into consideration all the above-said aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds at the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
