Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

The petition is for quashing of FIR No.53 dated 7.7.2013, registered under Sections 452, 427, 148, 149 IPC and 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, Section 3/4 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, at Police Station Khilchian, District Amritsar (Rural), along with all consequential proceedings.

Report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Baba Bakala Sahib received. Learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of both the parties and has reported that the parties have effected compromise in the State as well as in the complaint case, which is out of their free will and without any threat or pressure. Copies of the statements of the parties have also been enclosed with the report.

Since the parties have compromised, therefore, FIR No.53 dated 7.7.2013, registered under Sections 452, 427, 148, 149 IPC and 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, Section 3/4 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, at Police Station Khilchian, District Amritsar (Rural), along with all consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
