Prayer in this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioner-accused-S.L. Ahuja in case FIR No. 423, dated 25.06.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471 & 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sector 29 DLF Qutub Enclave Gurgaon.

It was submitted that petitioner-accused-S.L.Ahuja was neither the user nor purchaser of the vehicle, which was intercepted with fake number plates and against which there was an outstanding loan of Rs. 95 lacs raised from State Bank of India which has been cleared by payment of a sum of Rs.1,20,30,203/- (including penalty) to the bank on 07.04.2016

and as such No Objection Certificate (NOC) has been issued by the Bank.

Learned Counsel for the bank acknowledged the aforesaid factual position.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by SI Rahul, does not refute the aforesaid factual position and further states that upon investigation, the petitioner has been found innocent, therefore his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, the interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted to the petitioner by this Court's order dated 05.08.2015, is made absolute.

Disposed of.
