Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuing direction to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass and humiliate and physically and mentally torture the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that on the basis of complaint made by private respondents No.4 to 7 the petitioners have been summoned by the police frequently and now they are being threatened by the police at the instance of private respondents. He further states that he has approached to the concerned Senior Superintendent of Police but no remedial measures have been taken by him.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, Deputy A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned counsel

for the petitioners is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Deputy Superintendent of Police (D), Investigation, Police Line, Sangrur to take note the contents of the representation (Annexure P-1) dated 22.6.2016 and take appropriate action in accordance with law.
