JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 & 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6 as they have solemnized marriage against the wishes and consent of respondents No.4 to 6.

2. The petitioners moved representation (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2, for getting the needful done but no action has been taken so far.

3. Notice to respondents No.1 to 3, only at this stage.

4. At the asking of Court, Ms. Neelam Kashyap, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Haryana. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. Mr. Namit Khurana, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.4 to 6 and stated at bar that respondents No.4 to 6 have no objection from the marriage.

6. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, District Yamuna Nagar to look into the grievances of the petitioners unfolded by them in their representation dated July 25, 2016 (Annexure P-5) and if found necessary, take appropriate measures in accordance with law.

7. However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.
