Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that a false case has been registered against the petitioners at the instance of respondent No.4, who is inimical to the petitioners. The whole family of the petitioners has been involved in the case.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further states in order to bring false implications of the petitioners to the notice of higher authorities, the petitioner No.1 has submitted a representation dated 24.6.2016 (Annexure P-2) to the respondents No.2 and 3. He further states that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if a suitable direction is issued to

respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Moga, District Moga to take note of the representation (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to take action on the representation (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law.
