The petitioners seek the quashing of the orders Annexure P-7 and P-8, whereby they were communicated by the respondent-University that they were not eligible in the B.A. (Part -1) examination having secured less than 20% marks in the compartment subject in 10+2.

A period of 12 years has expired, since then. The petitioners would have appeared in the subsequent academic sessions and it is apparent that the present writ petition has become infructuous by sheer efflux of time. Even, as per order dated 24.09.2004 the process fee has not been filed by the counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
