This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 113 dated 03.04.2015 registered under Sections 15 and 27-A of NDPS Act at Police Station Dabwali, Sadar.

The petitioner along with his co-accused was found in possession of 80 kgs of choora post.

It is contended that the quantity recovered from the petitioner is non-commercial, therefore, the petitioner deserves the concession of bail.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel submits that two other FIRs under the NDPS Act are pending against the petitioner.

Keeping in view the antecedents of the petitioner, this Court is of the pinion that the petitioner does not deserve the grant of bail. Consequently, the petition is dismissed.
