Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.37 dated 28.2.2016, under Sections 420, 465 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhargo Camp, District Jalandhar.

This Court vide order dated 29.7.2016, while issuing notice of motion, has granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner states that he has the

instructions from the petitioner to make statement that he is ready to execute the sale deed in terms of agreement dated 10.9.2015 (Annexure P-3) entered between the parties. He further states that pursuant to order dated 29.7.2016 the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Mr. Navkiran Singh, learned counsel for the complainant, however, states that the petitioner has misrepresented to the extent that the land and building of 'Ma Chintpurni Education Society' is free from all incumbrances and sale deed executed alongwith possession.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Satwinder Singh, has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above and considering the fact that the petitioner is still ready to execute the sale deed, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 29.7.2016 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
