Prayer in the present petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. on behalf of the accused/petitioner-Hardeep Singh alias Deep is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 132, dated 19.12.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 21, 22, 61, 85, Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala.

There is alleged recovery of 20 vials of intoxicant liquid each containing 100 ML and 20 strips of intoxicant tablets each containing 10 tablets from the near gear box of the car, while co-accused/owner-cum-driver, namely, Gurdeep Singh was driving the car and the other co-accused-Sohanjeet Singh was sitting in the front seat. The petitioner concededly was sitting at the rear seat.

Learned State Counsel in the light of reply filed, submits that the alleged recovery, which is of commercial in nature, is attributed to all three occupants of the car, moreso, in the light of their disclosure statements. He further concedes that FSL report is yet to be received and challan is yet to be presented.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.
