The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.05 dated 16.01.2009, for the offence under Sections 328/498A/323 IPC registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, Distt. Sri Muktsar Sahib along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 18.07.2016 (Annexure P-2).

Petitioner Harjinder Singh had solemnized marriage with Jasvir Kaur-complainant/respondent No.2 on 31.07.2006 and they have two children from this wedlock. On account of misunderstanding and some temperamental differences between the parties, the present FIR was registered. Now, compromise has been effected between them and they have decided to reside together under one roof as husband and wife and complainant-Jasvir Kaur does not want to proceed further in the matter.

Jasvir Kaur-complainant/respondent No.2 is present in Court as identified by her counsel states that she has no objection if the present FIR is quashed against the petitioners. She also filed her affidavit in support of compromise, which is taken on record. On a specific query put by the Court, Jasvir Kaur-complainant/respondent No.2 has informed the court that she is happily residing with her husband and children.

Accordingly, FIR No.05 dated 16.01.2009, for the offence under Sections 328/498A/323 IPC registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, Distt. Sri Muktsar Sahib is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
