This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.60 dated 24.02.2016 registered under Sections 148/149/188/307/436/121 IPC and Section 8-B of National Highway Act at Police Station Murthal (Sonipat).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that invocation of Sections 436 and 307 IPC is highly debatable, the other offences are all

bailable and the petitioner has now been in custody since 18.04.2016.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from SI Kuldeep Singh has accepted the factual assertions but has stated that the invocation of Sections 436 and 307 IPC is well made out.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
