This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a complaint case bearing No.06/29.05.2014 under Sections 447, 506 IPC and Sections 3(x) of SC&SCT Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is already

a litigation pending between the parties and the dispute is under

adjudication and that the perusal of the complaint does not reveal that even any offence under the SC&ST Act has been made out.

In my opinion, it would be in the interest of justice if the petitioner appears before the trial Court tomorrow pursuant to the summons and moves an application for regular bail and the trial Court shall decide the said application tomorrow itself. Ordered accordingly.
