By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.255, dated 07.09.2015, registered under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC and Section 4 & 5 of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2012, at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the instant case. In fact, he himself is an investor in the company.

Heard.

The petitioner is one of the co-accused of main accused, Jagjit Singh @ Ladi who has failed to repay the amount allegedly

received by him and his co-accused. The bail petition of main accused has been dismissed by this Court, therefore, this Court is not inclined to grant the concession of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
