KULDIP SINGH, J (ORAL)

The learned counsel for the petitioners contended that the petitioners were attacked by the private respondents Nos. 7 to 10 but no action has been taken by the Police.

On behalf of the State, it is stated that there is a civil dispute between the parties and from the complaint of the complainant, it comes out that no cognizable offence was made out, therefore, no action was taken.

It is further stated that proceedings under Section 107 read with Section 150 were initiated against both the sides.

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It being so, the petitioner is at the liberty to file a criminal complaint before the Ilaqa Magistrate regarding the offence committed against them. However, at the same time, respondent State is directed to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is protected and they are not physically harmed.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
