INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty with further direction to respondent Nos.4 to 9 not to interfere in the peaceful and lawful married life of the petitioners.

Heard.

Without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ambala Cantt, Distt. Ambala, to look into the representation dated 25.07.2016 (Annexure P-4), moved by petitioner No.1, as per law and if he/she satisfies that there is any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners then take necessary steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, as per law.

However, it is made clear that this order, in no way, will affect any other proceedings pending or to be filed against the petitioners etc., which are to be dealt with independently as per law.
