This is a petition under Section 439 CrPC for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.125 dated 8.3.2016 under Sections 420,467,468,471,120-B IPC and subsequently section 201 IPC was added registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the similarly situated co-accused-Chandu @ Chander, who was the main beneficiary, has already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 12.7.2016 passed in CRM-M-13681 of 2016. It is a case of magisterial trial and the petitioners are in custody since 30.5.2016.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the factum of bail and the custody period of the petitioners.

Keeping in view the fact that the main beneficiary has already been released on bail and the custody period of the petitioner and the fact that it is a case of magisterial trial, I do not deem it appropriate to deny them the concession of bail.

Accordingly, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of trial Court.
