Petitioner, Rajender @ Raja, has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.153 dated 16.05.2016, registered at Police Station Sadar Jind, District Jind, under Sections 420, 406, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

In pursuance of the order dated 29.07.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is now not required for custodial interrogation.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner also says that compromise has been effected between the parties. Otherwise also, as per the version of FIR, money has been paid to accused other than the present petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 29.07.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
