JASPAL SINGH, J

This is a petition preferred by the petitioners under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No. 79, dated July 12, 2016, under Sections 406 & 420 of IPC, registered at Police Station Chabbewal, District Hoshiarpur, during the pendency of trial.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on July 29, 2016:-

“Inter alia, it has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the agreement of sale was in between Chanan Singh and Gurmukh Singh. Manjit Kaur-petitioner No.1 has been roped in the instant case just being the wife of Chanan Singh whereas Harvinder Singh-petitioner No.2 has nothing to do with the agreement of sale, if any. Moreover, if at all, allegation against the petitioners is concerned, they are only the attesting witnesses of the agreement/compromise (Annexure P-4). It has been further contended that neither petitioner No.1-Manjit Kaur nor petitioner No.2 -Harvinder Singh are beneficiary under the agreement(s).

Notice of motion to the respondent for 02.09.2016.

In the meanwhile, petitioners are directed to join the investigation. In the event of arrest, petitioners shall be released on pre-arrest bail at the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer subject to the conditions, as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel has submitted that in compliance of order dated July 29, 2016, petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for further investigation.

Taking into consideration the above facts of the case, interim order dated July 29, 2016 is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions, as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
