The petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Darshan Singh alleging that the petitioner as a member of unlawful assembly armed with weapons had attacked the complainant.

Counsel for the complainant has intervened to oppose the bail application bringing to the notice of the Court the photographs showing presence of the petitioner as a member of unlawful assembly.

Perusal of the said photograph indicates that the petitioner was not armed with any weapon. The petitioner is also not named in the FIR. He has been in custody w.e.f. 11.11.2015.

In view of the above said circumstances, petitioner can be granted the concession of bail. The petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the Area Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
