Prayer in this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the accused/petitioner-Simarjit Singh alias Simaranjit Singh in case FIR No. 06, dated 29.01.2011, for offences punishable under Sections 347, 380, 464, 465, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Lakhewali, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The dispute is between the complainant-mother and the accused/petitioner (son). The complainant has alleged that her husband (Rajinder Singh), who is not mentally sound, was abducted by her son (petitioner herein) in connivance with co-accused and agricultural land measuring fifteen acres was got transferred in favour of the petitioner/accused. Also, there was an allegation of snatching of Rs. 80,000/- and 13 Tolas of gold from the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this Court while issuing notice of motion on 30.07.2015 had granted interim protection to the present petitioner.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the parties submit that an amicable settlement has arrived at between the parties, and the complainant-mother is now staying with her son (petitioner) and she (complainant) does not wish to pursue the aforesaid FIR.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances, the interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted to the petitioner by this Court's order dated 30.07.2015, is made absolute.

Disposed of.
