INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to protect their life and liberty and to provide adequate security to protect them from respondent No.5, who is father of petitioner No.1. The petitioners, who are present in Court today, further contend that they being major have solemnized marriage with their own consent in accordance with law. The private respondent is not accepting the marriage of the petitioners and is extending threats to them. Copy of marriage certificate (Annexure P-1), marriage photographs (Annexure P-2), copy of Aadhaar Card of petitioner No.1 (Annexure P-3) and copy of ration card of petitioner No.2 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioners have been placed on record.

Mr. Naresh Kumar Ganga, Advocate has appeared and filed power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for respondent No.5 states that there is no threat to the petitioners from the private respondent.

Without going into the validity of the marriage, the present

petition is disposed of with the directions to the petitioners to contact

respondent No3, who, after his/her satisfaction that the petitioners are actually facing threat, shall take necessary steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from private respondent No.5, as per law.

However, it is made clear that this order, in no way, will affect any other proceedings pending or to be filed against the petitioners etc., which are to be dealt with independently as per law.
