The petitioner is seeking grant of regular bail in FIR No. 43 dated 03.04.2016 under Sections 365, 120B, 328, 384, 387, 342, 343, 376(2)H, 201 IPC registered at Police Station Raipur Rani, District Panchkula. The prosecutrix has alleged in the FIR on 02.04.2016 that she is a married lady and had gone out of matrimonial house after 10:00 P.M and the petitioner, who was present in his car, gave her some intoxicant and thereafter she accompanied him for seven days and stayed with him at Dehradun and Chandigarh in Gurudawars and Hotels. In her statement made under Section 164 (3) Cr.P.C report, it is stated that the prosecutrix has not given any intoxicant by the present petitioner and this fact is not disputed by the learned State counsel. It is further alleged that the petitioner was black-mailing her after she has solemnized the marriage. It has been stated by learned State counsel, on instructions from S.I Raghuvir Singh, that after presentation of challan 26 witnesses to be recorded. The prosecutrix was 24 years of age.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Judge/Duty Magistrate.
