By filing the present petition, under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in a complaint case bearing No. 14 dated 06.12.2008/25.01.2010, registered under Sections 302, 452, 382 and 148 read with Section 149 of IPC, at Police Station Majitha.

It is contended that all the co-accused have been acquitted. In pursuance of order dated 11.05.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioner surrendered before the competent Court. He further states that the deceased in fact had bed sores which is duly reflected in the judgment of acquittal. The petitioner is in custody since 21.05.2016.

On the other hand, learned State counsel opposes the bail application.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Considering the fact that co-accused stands acquitted and the petitioner himself surrendered before the trial Court in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of CJM/Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court.

Anything said herein above shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
