ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.278 dated 26.10.2014, registered under Sections 304-B IPC (Alternate Charge under Section 302 IPC), Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioner urges that the father in law had been allowed bail on 17.06.2016 by the Vacation Bench and the petitioner seeks parity and the allegations against him were similar. Counsel states that the petitioner is in custody since 23.11.2015 and the complainant has been examined.

Amardeep Kaur was married to the son of the petitioner. She had been married for 2½ years. She died a unnatural death in the matrimonial home. There are allegations of harassment and demand against

the mother in law. There are specific allegations that the demanded amount of Rs.1 lac in cash was taken by Umesh who handed the same to his mother.

It was stated that the deceased was not conceiving and she was taking treatment. The documents available on record show that they pertain to December, 2012. The allegations are serious. The trial is proceeding at a fast pace. No ground for bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
