Petitioner remained on interim bail during awaiting period of chemical examiner report. He has been in custody w.e.f. 4.8.2015 for having been found in possession of 250 grams of intoxicating powder which contained Alprazolam to the extent of 0.20%.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not misused the liberty.

I have considered that facts and circumstances of the case. Petitioner remained on interim bail till 4.8.2015.

No witness of the prosecution having been examined till date as per instructions from ASI Harbans Singh, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction that trial Court shall make earnest endeavour to conclude the entire trial by examining the prosecution witnesses within a period of four months after the next date of hearing. In case the prosecution agency fails to examine all the witnesses within the said period, the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail to its satisfaction.
