INDERJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.81 dated 10.05.2016, registered at Police Station Guhla, District Kaithal, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 506 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Mr. Vikramjit Singh, Addl. A. G. Haryana has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, petitioner No.1-Satnam Singh is stated to be armed with *lathi* and he gave its blow on the left arm of Amrik Singh, petitioner No.2-Swaran Singh

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exhorted all the assailants to teach a lesson to the complainant party by physically assaulting them and petitioner No.3-Hans Raj gave slaps and fist blows. The main accused is Balwant Singh.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 29.07.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. Nothing is to be recovered from the present petitioners.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 29.07.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
