JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, namely, Juber and Pappan in case FIR No.119 dated 14.06.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 3/8 and 2/80 of Cow Slaughter Act registered with Police Station Nagina, District Mewat.

Allegations against both the petitioners are that they are involved in the selling of Cow Beef and when the police party reached the spot, they are alleged to have escaped leaving behind the freshly cut piece of Beef as also live Cows meant for slaughtering.

It is contended that neither the petitioners were apprehended at the spot nor any recoveries effected from them. Except bald statement no

incriminating material is collected connecting the petitioners to the said offences.

It is further contended that petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is no longer required as no other recoveries are to be made from them. It is further contended that challan has also been presented.

Learned State Counsel assisted by HC Mani Ram submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 30th of July, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
