The petitioner is a lady. She claims that she has purchased a plot measuring 5 marlas situated in Diwan Colony, Pehowa from Kamlesh Kaur and others vide a registered sale deed but she has been obstructed by the police officials on the ground that there is some stay order passed by the Court regarding construction.

The petitioner has filed a representation to Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra alleging that the accused persons have forcibly sold the plot to the petitioner and that she wants to receive her sale consideration back, so that she can purchase some other plot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per his knowledge there is no civil litigation pending regarding the plot purchased by the petitioner. The petitioner appears to have issued a notice to Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the nature of the allegations in Annexure P-5 and legal notice Annexure P-6.

Notice to Advocate General, Haryana.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Gurdas Singh Salwara, DAG, Haryana, present in the Court, accepts notice.

Without expression of any opinion whether any cognizable offence is made out from the allegations in Annexure P-5 and P-6, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction that the allegations of the petitioner that she has been duped and has been deprived of the fruit of the subject matter purchased by her on payment of sale consideration, may be looked into by an appropriate inquiry under the supervision of Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra. In case, any cognizable offence is made out on inquiry or there appears to be any threat to the petitioner, it will be open to the concerned police officer to take appropriate action in accordance with law.

This petition is disposed of expecting that necessary decision will be taken by the Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra within a period of three months after the receipt of copy of this order.
