JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Through the instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner-Sube Singh has sought issuance of direction to respondent Nos.2 & 3 to take necessary action in case FIR No.155, dated 07.06.2015, under Section 346 of IPC, registered at Police Station Nangal Chaudhri, District Mahendergarh and to trace out the whereabouts of his daughter Poonam Kumari (aged about 19 years) who is stated to be missing from the house since June, 2015.

Undeniably, daughter of the petitioner was granted protection vide *CRM-M-20328 of 2015* decided on 22.06.2015, after the registration of the FIR in question. Moreover, the Investigating Officer of the case was

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directed to apprise the status of the FIR in question. During the pendency of the instant petition, Poonam Kumari-daughter of the petitioner appeared before the Jurisdictional Magistrate on 01.09.2016 and her statement was recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C.

A perusal of her statement clearly reveals that she has solemnized the marriage at her own will and accord with Gautam Kumar s/o Jitender and is living with him happily. It has further been stated that she does not want to take any action against her husband and others & further she intends to live with her husband Gautam Kumar.

In view of the statement of Poonam Kumari-daughter of the petitioner, instant petition has rendered infructuous and as such, it stands disposed of.
