On asking of the Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, Deputy A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

In view of the above, the respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar, is directed to look into the representation dated 30.6.2016 (Annexure P-3) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
