The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 424 dated 21.09.2015 registered at Police Station Kharkhoda, District Sonapat under Sections 498A, 307, 34 IPC (Section 304-B added later on).

The petitioner is the father-in-law. The deceased was married to the son of the petitioner in 2011. She made a dying declaration on the basis of which the FIR was registered. She had stated that kerosene oil was poured in the morning by his husband and his parents and she was set ablaze.

Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to the statement of PW2. The prosecution had cited a relative of the petitioner as a prosecution witness who in the cross-examination has supported the accused.

It is for the trial Court to see whether his statement has to be accepted ovwe the dying declaration. The allegations are serious.

No case for bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
